



PHOTOGRAPHIC PLATES is a new project of the *Foundation Brother the Sun* run by the St. Maximilian Kolbe Centre, which is located in Harmęże, near Auschwitz, a few kilometres from the gate of a II World War nazi-concentration camp on the site of the former subcamp of Auschwitz- Harmęże.







An exhibition of drawings by the deceased in 2009 year artist Marian Kołodziej is presented in the St. Maximilian Kolbe Center in Harmęże.



Marian Kołodziej was in the first transport to Auschwitz, with the prisoner number 432.

He survived at Auschwitz. He witnessed the most known, traumatic events, including most of the deeds of Father Maximilian Kolbe.

After leaving the camp, he graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Cracow. He worked as a set designer in theatres in Gdańsk (Danzig).

He have not shared his camp memories with anyone. This changed after he got ill and was partially paralysed. Then, despite the limitations due to illness, lying on the table he began to create drawings, which threw out of self trauma camp hell.
